

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At VOCA, we change lives by changing work. Through teaching, coaching, and leadership services, we bring God's wisdom to work for over 5,000 people each year. Launched in 2015, we are beginning our seventh year with a solid track record and a plan for expanding our impact. The pages that follow provide an overview of our work and an invitation for you to join us.

Weighed down by work: According to Gallup, the number one thing everyone in the world wants is "a good job." Every day the VOCA team talks to people who cannot see a way forward in their work and are desperate to find God's will for their careers.

Our Why: The U.S. workforce stands at 160 million people. That's roughly half the population of the country. Workers spend more waking hours on the job than in any other single activity.

The Challenge: Only 28% of Christians report living their faith in the context of their work. With this separation of spirituality and work life, the majority of Christians report feelings of disillusionment and burnout, and believe unhelpful career myths at rates similar to their non-Christian counterparts. In short, they don't see their work within the larger Biblical story. They are like sheep without a shepherd.

The Upside: We know that vocationally focused discipleship, teaching, and counsel have an outsized impact on individual lives. Finding God in the fabric of the day-to-day leads to deep personal change and serves as a stepping stone for spiritual influence.

Multi-channel approach: We deploy a multi-channel approach to reach people with work-transforming principles and practices:

- Teaching: deliver digitally and in person, reaching around 4,200 people annually.
- Coaching: in-person and virtual coaching, providing a miniature biblical community aimed at change. We reached 139 people in 2021.
- Leadership Development: provide advising and consulting to organizational leaders, data to Faith and Work organizations, and handson leadership in New York City.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Research Driven: Using proven techniques of qualitative research, we listen to our constituents with the annual Dilemmas project, client feedback, and the "What Women Want at Work" study.

Active Partnerships: VOCA is pleased to work alongside other faith and work initiatives across the country. We have been selected by Redeemer City to City to deliver their Gotham Fellows program virtually. We pursue research and create content with faith and work institutes in Nashville, Denver, and Chicago, to name a few.

Ripples: Though a challenge to quantify, we believe that when you impact one person's work, you impact a collection of people around them. We conservatively estimate a 10x ripple effect, bringing our estimated influence total for 2021 to over 80,000 people worldwide.

Funding Goals for 2022: We are working to raise our \$200,000.00 annual fund and an additional \$150,000 for strategic expansion, for a total of \$350,000.

Gains and Losses: VOCA equips the Church to effectively live its faith out in the world. As we are funded and effective, lives change, workplaces change, and the kingdom strategically expands. If we fail, if we lack resources, a grand opportunity will be lost.



WEIGHED DOWN BY WORK

Work is weighing on Amelia. She is good at her job but wonders if her job is good for her. Over the last few years, the culture seems to have changedless relational, more transactional. The fear that drew people together on her team in the early pandemic has given way to a transactional distance. Her boss has not kept commitments to increase her pay and provide new training. She's not moving forward. For months her motivation has lagged. Is she burning out?

She's in a real quandary about what to do. Colleagues have gotten swept up in the great resignation. They are making moves, finding work they say is better. She wonders, should I leave? Ultimately she wants to follow God's plan for her whole life, including her work. She is at a loss regarding how she will know what that plan is.

Her dad gives her the same old advice, "Just be happy you have a job." Her mom wonders if it might be an opportunity to shine as others are leaving. Friends commiserate with her instead of offering advice. Her pastor offers his best counsel but he's out of touch with her daily reality at work. She's still left puzzled.



She decides to go online. Googling topics like "toxic bosses," "the great resignation," "changing careers," and "burnout." She drowns in informationmuch of it very surface level, all of it selling something. She is frustrated, lost, and holding out little hope.

Coaching provides the optimal space for transformation. In coaching, the client builds a relationship with a certified, Christian partner. They are challenged to take responsibility for their path. They are given resources to find God's wisdom for their work. To make coaching affordable for people at all levels in their careers, we rely on financial support from donors to offer subsidies and scholarships.

VOCA's core coaching programs include:

- 3. General Coaching: A customized, confidential, and professional development alliance that empowers professionals to address pressing dilemmas and accomplish what's important in their vocational calling
- 4. Ascend: Framework for the first 90 days of a new job to launch strong and start leading with impact in the first few months

INCREASE VOCA'S IMPACT TO ADVANCE GOD'S KINGDOM

The work of VOCA delivers kingdom power and direction into the world of work. Donor funds enable us to maintain and expand our work.

If we fail to reach working Christians, they are left on the sidelines, isolated from God's work in the world. The advancement of the Kingdom is obscured. The world of work is left to its own destructive devices. But with your investment, VOCA can disciple more people in every corner of the world to see greater transformation.

We are seeking \$200,000 for our annual fund, plus \$150,000 in growth dollars. Our growth priorities are as follows:

- 1. Scholarships-Award 30 scholarships to help professionals find their vocational path: \$15,000.00
- 2. Fellows Program-a year-long, holistic discipleship initiative in partnership with Redeemer City to City. Costs for the first year, training, scholarships, and promotion: \$80,000
- 3. Women at Work Program-Content, training, and opportunities to connect working women: \$20,000.00
- 4. VOCA National In-Person Events-regular events in Dallas, Orlando, Philadelphia, and Nashville to further impact clients there and increase our reach: \$10,000.00
- 5. Increase Network-Grow our virtual contact base from 3,500 to 10,000, increasing our content engagement and coaching clients by 300%. Cost for communications talent and initiatives: \$25,000.00

(Continued from pg 2) ... A friend from church tells Amelia about VOCA. "VOCA has Christian coaches who can help you get your career and calling sorted out. That's what they do every day and it's faith-based." Amelia sets up a complimentary coaching session with Sarah who gets to know her, listens carefully to the ins and outs of her challenge, and explores what has and hasn't worked. Amelia can't remember the last time she felt so heard!

But with the unkept promise of a raise and all her other responsibilities, how can she afford professional coaching? Then, in a follow-up email, she reads, "Should you need financial assistance, generous donors have provided a scholarship fund for VOCA's group program." She fills out the online application and waits.

Amelia doesn't have to wait long. She receives word that her scholarship has been approved. After she pays her portion, Amelia is registered and ready to start.

Every week, she meets with a virtual group of others in different industries, different parts of the country, yet they are all struggling with uncertainty, the feelings of failure, and the glimmers of hope that break through from time to time. Amelia benefits from the biblical community, explicit biblical texts that apply to work, the relationship with a professional guide, and spiritual practices that lead to true transformation.

Weekly meetings remind her of the promises that God will guide and provide. She learns more about herself and the process of discovering her next assignment. She learns about her God-given skills through professional, objective assessments.

Exploratory conversations turn into interviews. And before the 10th and final session, Amelia takes a new job—one that will challenge her in fresh ways and one whose culture she vetted carefully before signing on the dotted line. She even received a significant bump in her salary after following VOCA's training on compensation negotiation. The final unit on gratitude and giving inspired her. She gives a gift to VOCA for twice her scholarship-making it possible for VOCA to serve others like her.

To date she continues in her job, with the confidence that she is where God wants her to be for now. Because of donors like you, Amelia was able to find the wisdom for work she needed with VOCA.




